It's with mixed emotions that I report that one of our founding partners, Dr. Roger Steininger is retiring from day-to-day operations while remaining a Director of NuLegacy. Roger has had a long and illustrious career in discovering metals...as is referenced in the news release linked above...so I won't dwell on that here. I will dwell instead on the geological/discovery team that we built together to carry on the work.

Our geo-team is a mix of young, energetic and enthusiastic geologists highly proficient in modern computer modelling techniques and the geotechnical sciences as well as several mature 'graybeards' with direct discovery experience. There's nothing like having discovered one of these giant Carlin-style deposits to prep you for the discovery of another.

Since time (and people's attention spans) are short, today I'm going to focus on highlighting just a few aspects of our geotechnical/discovery capability:

- We have three former Barrick Gold Corporation Executive/Senior VPs of exploration and production as independent directors on NuLegacy.
- In addition, we have recruited three of Barrick's top geotechnical team to NuLegacy's exploration team, most recently (Jan 1, 2018) Mr. Charles Weakley, whose insights, to quote Mike Niehuser, analyst for Scarsdale Equities, "gained from decades of Barrick's exploration...may have taken years off the exploration timeline for the Red Hill property possibly leading to a major discovery in 2018".
- Altogether four of NuLegacy's discovery team have been publicly credited (i.e. - Thayer Lindsay award recipients, etc.) as being responsible for or substantially contributing to the discovery of four of Barrick's best gold deposits.

- As well we have the several talented individuals that helped develop the original framework of the Red Hill property's potential.

So, need I say more...we are well staffed to find the next elephant in the Cortez gold-trend of Nevada with drilling scheduled to begin early in May.
